

## SEMINARS AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

The 3 CFU for the “Seminars and Other Activities” course may be earned in one of the following ways:

- By successfully passing the “Advanced Topics in Data Science” course.
- By obtaining an English proficiency certificate at B2 level (productive skills) or higher.
  - The certification must be obtained by attending the course 50-hr English (B2 productive skills) during the degree program; **pre-obtained certifications are not accepted.**
- By attending two mini-courses (12 hours each) offered as part of the “Seminars and Other Activities” course.
  - At least 80% attendance is required in each mini-course.
  - A written essay on one of the attended mini-courses must be submitted.
  - The essay must be submitted via the Moodle page. A dedicated section on the Moodle page will be opened during the exam session.
  - At least two mini-courses will be organized each academic year.
  - The organization of mini-courses in the first semester is not guaranteed; please take this into account when planning your study schedule.
  - Remote attendance via Zoom is allowed **only** in specific and motivated cases (e.g., internships or Erasmus abroad) and must be explicitly approved by the “Seminars and Other Activities” Committee.

**Note:** All updates, communications, and the announcements of mini-course schedules will be posted on the Moodle page of the course.

**Additional Information:** Please note that the three options above correspond to three distinct courses, each of which will appear separately on the student’s academic transcript. The options related to “Seminars and Other Activities” specifically refer to the mini-course activities, while for the other options please refer to their respective Moodle pages.
