Call for Applications for 6 Scholarships for International students enrolled in the second year of the Master's Degree in Food Industry Engineering and the Master's Degree in Management Engineering at the Department of Management and Engineering – DTG (Academic Year 2025/26).

Internationalisation is one of the key objectives underlying the activities of the University of Padua. Accordingly, the Department of Management and Engineering (DTG) has decided to promote a scholarship programme to boost and support the academic career of international students not residing in Italy and holding a non-Italian citizenship and a foreign entry qualification.

The present call for applications is for 6 scholarships provided by the Department of Management and Engineering (DTG) and is intended for international students enrolled in the second year of English-taught Master's degree programs, as approved by the Council of the Department on June 19, 2025. The scholarships are distributed as follows:

- 3 scholarships for the Master's Degree in Food Industry Engineering
- 3 scholarships for the Master's Degree in Management Engineering

Scholarship amount and conditions

Each scholarship includes an allowance of € 2,000.00 (gross for the recipient). Recipients are still required to pay the first installment of student fees for enrolment in the second year of their chosen Master's program. Scholarships cannot be combined with any other grant awarded by other public institutions. If a candidate has been awarded more than one scholarship, he/she must choose which one to accept. Awardees are required, under their own responsibility, to notify the Department of Management and Engineering (DTG) of any event that would result in holding multiple scholarships after submitting the application, by contacting: didattica.dtg@unipd.it.

Admission requirements

To be eligible for the selection, under penalty of exclusion, applicants must:

1. not have Italian citizenship (except for dual citizenship);
2. be enrolled in the second year of one of the two Master's degree programs for which the scholarships are established (cohort 2024);
3. have obtained at least 39 ECTS credits at the time of submitting the application;
4. have paid the first installment of tuition fees for the second year of the Master's degree program (1st installment due by September 30, 2025);
5. not be the recipient of other scholarships awarded by public institutions (e.g., Region, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, etc.) at the time of application.

The applicants who fail to meet one or more of these requirements are not eligible for selection for scholarships. All the students fulfilling the above-mentioned requirements are automatically admitted to the selection. No additional documents are needed in addition to those indicated in "Admission

requirements."

Selection Procedures and How to Apply

All students who meet the above-mentioned requirements may apply by filling in the appropriate form, available from October 1, 2025 to October 16, 2025 in the Moodle-STEM platform of their Master's program.

Selection Procedure

All applications will be evaluated by a specific Evaluating Commission appointed by the Chair of each degree program. The scholarships will be awarded to the most deserving international candidates based on the following formula:

Score = 3 × weighted average grade + ECTS credits obtained by September 30, 2025

In case of equal score, the youngest candidate will be given priority.

Acceptance

Candidates selected for a scholarship will receive a specific scholarship offer from the Didactic Office of the Department with the procedures and deadlines for accepting it.

If the recipients decline admission to the second year of the Master's degree program or no longer meet the "*Admission requirements*" at the time of scholarship acceptance, the scholarships will be awarded by the Evaluating Commission to the next eligible candidate by **no later than November 14, 2025**.

Payment methods and requirements to maintain scholarship eligibility A.Y. 2025/26

Scholarships will be paid via bank transfer in the amount of € 2,000.00 (gross for the recipient) by December 2025.

Information on the processing of personal data

Personal data shall be processed in compliance with the principles and provisions of EU Regulation 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation) and for the sole purposes of the competition procedure. For detailed information: <http://www.unipd.it/privacy>.

The Administration reserves the right to check the truthfulness of the admission and incompatibility requirements. Without prejudice to the criminal sanctions provided for in art. 76 of Italian Presidential Decree DPR no. 445/2000, should checks prove statements to be false, the scholarship recipient shall lose the benefit eligibility.

This call for applications is translated into English for informational purposes only. Should any disputes arise and for all legal purposes, only the Italian version shall be considered valid.
