





WHO ARE INCELS?

romantic frustration.


accompanied by hatred, misogyny, misanthropy, self-pity and racism.




THEORETICAL GROUNDING

We chose this question to understand the threat of incels; how involved they are be/may become in alt-right violence and to highlight the relation between misogynist terrorism and domestic terrorism.

In a first research we have found that there is a strong association between incels and far right groups (Proud Boys in particular).

The network will show affiliations between ideological groups; linking Incels to other altright groups (and specific terrorist events) using 4Chan, Reddit, and Youtube.
