Internship and final exam: guidelines

Academic year 2025-26



- Mandatory (formally 6 credits for a total of 150 hours)
- Where:
 - At an Italian entity (private or public)
 - At a foreign entity (private or public), also through study programs to study abroad
 - At a university laboratory (in Italy or abroad)
- It can be aimed at the writing of the thesis, or not
- Curricular (for students) and extracurricular (for recent graduates, within 12 months from the degree)

Academic tutor / thesis supervisor

- They may be two different professors
- Students must ask a professor to assume the role of tutor/supervisor
- Thesis connected with the internship: one professor may assume the dual role of academic tutor and thesis supervisor



- At the end of the internship period, the **internship completion certificate (AFT)** must be completed. This contains a brief report on the internship carried out and must be signed by the host company
- The AFT must be **sent via e-mail** to Dr. Monica De Spirito, Career Service (stage@unipd.it)
- The internship must be recorded by registering on the appropriate list on Uniweb (as for other exams). The list is opened close to the registration date, and the **relevant Committee verifies the results of the internship**
- The deadline for registering the internship depends on the date of the graduation session and is usually about ten days before the deadline for registering exams

FINAL EXAM – GENERAL INFORMATION

The **final exam** consists of the student writing an original thesis under the guidance of a supervisor, and presenting and discussing it before the degree committee.

The **master's thesis** is a written paper of a high scientific standard, relating to an original project or research in one of the disciplines of the master's degree program, possibly carried out at a company, laboratory, or institution

The thesis will be **discussed** before a committee appointed by the Director of the relevant Department or, on his or her behalf, by the President of the relevant School.



Two types:

- **Connected with the internship**
 - Illustrates/reports the results of a **project** carried out by the student during the internship
 - 'Carried out by the student' means that the student contributed to developing (even as part of a working group) a **solution** (at any stage of implementation) to a business problem
- **Bibliographic/speculative/research (empirical)**
 - Based on the collection and analysis of documents and/or empirical data (from laboratories, surveys, etc.)



THESIS CONNECTED WITH THE INTERNSHIP

- The activities carried out during the internship should provide sufficient (and appropriate) material for writing the thesis
- Internships that involve general activities do NOT normally offer the possibility of writing a thesis. In order to write a thesis based on the internship, it is necessary to develop an original project within the company in one of the disciplines of the master's degree program
- It is advisable to draft a ***thesis project*** as soon as the internship begins, to be shared with the company tutor and the academic tutor
- Formally, the curricular internship requires 150 hours of attendance at the company, but it usually lasts longer, especially if connected with the thesis (3-6 months)



- **Four sessions** (July, October, December, March/April)
- The application to the graduation session must be submitted via ***Uniweb***
- All exams must be completed and recorded at least 15 days before the start date of the session (published on the university website)
- You must also have your Study Plan approved – the plan cannot be changed after submitting your graduation application
- At the time of submission, you must be up to date with your tuition fee payments



- Pay attention to the deadlines for submitting your graduation application and its approval, which generally close well before the session (normally 2 months)
- Pay attention to the dates and procedures for uploading your thesis
- You must complete the questionnaire on the ALMALAUREA website
- For the English curriculum, the thesis must be written and discussed in English, and an extended summary of the work carried out must also be prepared in Italian
